Skills required:

- Able to meet deadlines, juggle multiple projects at once, and work well under pressure
- Flexible schedule in the case that news breaks out of the 9 to 5 time frame or if the story calls for it. For example: if a city council meeting is at night, reporters take time off during the day.
- Able to use a field recorder and cut tape using a digital audio workstation like Adobe Audition
- Familiarity with a range of social media platforms, content management systems
- At least some broadcast news experience (such as an internship)
- A positive attitude and ability to see the bigger picture
