- 4) Prepare news content, including images, audio files, and text, for use on KSRM and partner websites and for social media

- 6) Produce public announcements as needed
- 7) Attend staff meetings and events
- 8) Conduct live emergency broadcasts as needed; i.e. severe weather, wildfires, road closures, aviation accidents, etc.
- 9) Other duties as assigned

- 2) Excellent announcing and production skills; attention to detail
- 3) Excellent computer skills, preferred experience with Microsoft Word, Adobe Audition, and WordPress
- 4) Familiarity with radio automation operations, particularly Profit NexGen
